भूमिका

जवाहर नवोदय विद्यालय, वेच्चूचिरा, पत्तनंतिट्टा, 1986 की राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति के अनुसरण पर , नवंबर 1986 में स्थापित किया गया था. विद्यालय के उद्देश्य यह है कि जिले के ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों से प्रतिभावान विद्यार्थियों को उच्च गुणवत्ता की शिक्षा प्रदान करना है. अपनी स्थापना के बाद से पुराना एनवीएस के संस्थापक पिता के निर्धारित लक्ष्य पूरा करने के लिए विद्यालय अपना कार्य कर रहा है. छात्रों के चयन, केंद्रीय माध्यमिक शिक्षा बोर्ड, नई दिल्ली , के द्वारा संचालित एक प्रतियोगी परीक्षा के आधार पर होता है. चयनित छात्रों को निः शुल्क बोर्डिंग और लॉजिंग सुविधा के साथ , पाठ्य पुस्तकें, लेखन सामग्री आदि उपलब्ध कराई जाती है. जिले के मान्यता प्राप्त स्कूलों में पांचवीं कक्षा में अध्ययन करने वाले छात्रों को नवोदय विद्यालय समिति द्वारा निर्धारित शर्तों के आधार पर छठी कक्षा के प्रवेश परीक्षा में बैठने के पात्र हैं . नवोदय विद्यालय समिति, मानव संसाधन विकास मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार के मंत्रालय के अधीन एक स्वायत्त संगठन है. इस विद्यालय के छात्रों को अखिल भारतीय माध्यमिक विद्यालय परीक्षा(दसवीं कक्षा) और अखिल भारतीय वरिष्ठ विद्यालय प्रमाण पत्र परीक्षा (बारहवीं कक्षा) के लिए तैयारी करता है और सराहनीय परिणाम प्राप्त करता है ।बारहवीं कक्षा के बाद बाहर जाने वाले 85 % विद्यार्थियों विविध व्यावसायिक पाठ्यक्रमों में प्रवेश पाते हैं । विद्यालय में प्रवेश पाये छात्रों के सर्वांगीण विकास की सभी संभावनाएं विद्यालय तलाश रहा है.

विद्यालय ने प्रत्येक वर्ष इऑडउ परीक्षाओं में गणनात्मक और गुणवत्तापूर्ण परिणाम प्राप्त किये हैं । 17 विद्यार्थियों ने कक्षा 10 में पिछले साल विशेष योग्यता के साथ अ1 श्रेणी प्राप्त किये।नवोदय विद्यालय समिति के आयुक्त, उपायुक्त तथा सहायक आयुक्त से उत्साह एवं प्रेरणा आर्जित करके हम अपने उद्देश्य व लक्ष्य शैक्षिक वर्ष 2021-22 में प्राप्त करने के लिये आप सभी के सामने प्रस्तुत कर रहे हैं ।

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GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT VIDYALAYA

The National Policy of Education -1986 envisaged the establishment of pace setting schools in various parts of the country. Accordingly a scheme was formulated under which it was decided to set up residential schools called Navodaya Vidyalayas on an average of one in each district. The school allotted for Pathanamthitta district started functioning in the Government High School, Mannadissala, Vechoochira. Subsequently it was shifted to the adjacent permanent site, which covers 23 acres of land. It stands in full dazzle with the green mountains that surround it.

The construction activities have been carried out by the Government agencies:

- i) CENTRAL PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT
- ii) KERALA STATE CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION LTD.

Apart from a well-designed compound wall and barbed wire fencing, the following buildings have been constructed.

1. Academic Block
2. Administrative Block
3. Multi-Purpose Hall.
4. Dining Hall & Kitchen
5. Ten dormitories with a capacity to accommodate 560 students.
6. Forty - two units of staff quarters.

The first batch of Class VI students were admitted in 1986. In 1991, the students appeared for Class X, C.B.S.E Examination.

ACADEMIC ACTION PLAN -2023-24

1. IMPLEMENTATION OF NEP

The National Education Policy 2020 is the first education policy of the 21st century and aims to address the many growing developmental imperatives of our country. This Policy proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance, to create a new system that is aligned with the aspirational goals of 21st century education, including SDG4, while building upon India's traditions and value systems. The purpose of our education system is to develop good human beings capable of rational thought and action, possessing compassion and empathy, courage and resilience, scientific temper and creative imagination, with sound ethical values. It aims at producing engaged, productive, and contributing citizens for building an equitable, inclusive, and plural society as envisaged by our Constitution. The fundamental principles that are guiding the institution are

- recognizing, identifying, and fostering the unique capabilities of each student, by sensitizing teachers as well as parents to promote each student's holistic development in both academic and non-academic spheres;
- emphasis on conceptual understanding rather than rote learning and learning-for-exams;
- creativity and critical thinking to encourage logical decision-making and innovation;
- promoting multilingualism and the power of language in teaching and learning;
- life skills such as communication, cooperation, teamwork, and resilience;
- extensive use of technology in teaching and learning, removing language barriers, increasing access for Divyang students, and educational planning and management;
- teachers and faculty as the heart of the learning process – their recruitment, continuous professional development, positive working environments and service conditions;

A practice-based curriculum for Grades 6-8 is appropriately designed by NCERT while framing the NCFSE 2020-21. All students will participate in a 10-day bagless period sometime during Grades 6-8 where they intern with local vocational experts such as carpenters, gardeners, potters, artists, etc. Children will be given periodic exposure to activities outside school through visits to places/monuments of historical, cultural and tourist importance, meeting local artists and craftsmen and visits higher educational institutions in their village/Tehsil/district.

The aim of assessment in our culture of our institution will shift from one that is summative and primarily tests rote memorization skills to one that is more regular and formative, is more competency-based, promotes learning and development for our students, and tests higher-order skills, such as analysis, critical thinking, and conceptual clarity. The progress card of all students for school-based assessment, which is communicated by schools to parents, is completely designed by NCERT. The progress card will be a holistic, 360-degree, multidimensional report that reflects in great detail the progress as well as the uniqueness of each learner in the cognitive, affective, and psychomotor domains.

Olympiads and competitions in various subjects will be conducted in our institution, with clear coordination and progression from school to local to state to national levels, to ensure that all students may participate at all levels for which they qualify. With internet-connected smart phones or tablets available in schools, online apps with quizzes, competitions, assessments, enrichment materials, and online communities for shared interests will be developed, and will work to enhance all the aforementioned initiatives, as group activities for students with appropriate supervision of teachers.

Continuous Professional Development (CPD)

Teachers will be given continuous opportunities for self-improvement and to learn the latest innovations and advances in their professions. These are offered in multiple modes, including in the form of local, regional, state, national, and international workshops as well as online teacher development modules.

DEVELOPING COMMUNICATION SKILLS:

In the wake of globalization, English has become the international language of business and communication. It occupies a unique place of importance being a living and ever growing language widely spoken and written. Therefore, it is necessary to prepare the students of Navodaya to be proficient in all the four basic skills namely listening, speaking, reading and writing which is of paramount importance. Deliberate steps should be taken to nurture effective communication.

There are different approaches and methodologies available for effective teaching of English. It is advisable to adopt Communicative Language Teaching (CLT) approach in English in all classes so as to provide an opportunity for learner to freely acquire proficiency in all the four major skills of the language as this approach provides enough scope for integration of skills rather than teaching a skill in isolation.

A few ways to develop communicative skills in students:

- a) Effective classroom management in language class by the teacher.
- b) Activities for strengthening communicative skills like Role play / seminar / panel discussion / debate / dialogue / picture / description / pick & speak / interview / extempore / elocution / etc., should be taken up in pair / group / whole class / whole school regularly.
- c) The role of English Literary Club (ELC) in particular and other clubs in general should function effectively for creating enough opportunities and situations for students to acquire proficiency in the language.
- d) School Assembly should be a forum for developing public speaking skill within the given time apart from teachers speaking effectively on important occasions for effective models and guest speakers arranged for this purpose.
- e) Regular use of Audio/Video, TV should be exploited for learning the skills of the language. Regular viewing of TV programmes like News, Talk show, Panel Discussion, Interview may help learn the language effectively.

News should be screened by the teachers. News of petty political squabbles, reports of abhorrent evil deeds etc. should not find any place. Remarks/comments, critical of the government or disrespectful of the culture and tradition of the country are forbidden.

Noble, profound thoughts of great men / National Leaders / Men of Letters / Philosophers / Educationalists, Moralists and exhortations from scriptures should be selected. Great poetical stanzas / couplets inspiring virtuous actions with brief interpretation are also appropriate.

- f. Patriotic group song and speech.

Speech should be on topics of informative, educational value. Relating simple/classical stories, fables conveying messages of morals and virtues. Criticism of government / established precepts and practices are not allowed.

- g. Quiz.

- h. National Anthem.

(i) Academic Points.

Points will be awarded on the basis of the performance of the students in various Unit Tests, Term Tests, Assignments, projects etc and will be given more weightage while deciding the best house

3. Cleanliness and Beautification.
